Our Compton theatre pipe organ has suffered a couple of failures in the past month. One of the regulators split causing a massive air leak. (A regulator is a large box which controls the pressure of the air being delivered to the pipes.) Because the sound of escaping air was so noisy, the regulator had to be removed and repaired. Our thanks to IAN McLEAN for assisting with the repair, gluing the leather parts of the regulator back together.

The week that the regulator was away being repaired, one of the notes on the accompaniment manual started playing and would not stop. This was not a typical cypher where only one pipe is affected, rather all the stops on the accompaniment manual were affected. The fault was a broken part in the mechanism of one of the relay boxes which prevented the note from turning off.
