The Meeting was declared open by the President, Rodney Raymond, at 14:00

MINUTES

Minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting had previously been circulated via the *Tremulant*.

The President's Report was circulated with the notice of meeting. Rodney briefly summarised the main items in the report and also indicated that the membership consisted of 62 members in 2016, a drop from 64 in 2015.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. **Advertising.** Arthur Stevens asked why we advertised concerts at Karrinyup but they do not seem to promote our concerts. Rodney explained that our concert with Dave Wickerham was advertised by Stirling Theatre Organ Productions (STOP) and that we do work together with STOP. The concert with Nathan Avakian in November is being arranged in collaboration with STOP. *(Since the AGM, organisation of the concert with Nathan Avakian has changed with TOSA(SA) arranging the concert, rather than Stirling Theatre Organ Productions).*

Philip Surtees suggested that we should continue to advertise with “In the Pipeline”, the newsletter of The Organ Society of Western Australia. Rodney indicated that our 2017 concert dates have been forwarded to the editor of “In the Pipeline”.

Bernard Varney suggested that we should advertise in the ‘Hot List’ in “The Sunday Times”.

2. **Probus and Rotary Clubs.** Simone Collins suggested that we offer to talk about the organ, its heritage and TOSA at Probus or Rotary Clubs. Agreed that this was worth pursuing.

There being no further business, the meeting closed at 14:40.
